Re: Billing for Claim Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Data Collection Services

The Texas Department of Insurance, Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) adopted the Texas claim EDI release 3.1.4 standard on March 9, 2022. As a result, DWC's designated data collection agent, Verisk, will begin billing insurance carriers, other than governmental entities, for one-time set-up costs and claim data collection activities for the first year of claim EDI 3.1.4 transactions.

Verisk will bill insurance carriers a percentage of Verisk's total costs based upon historical transaction volume. They will bill each insurance carrier half of their allocation of one-time costs immediately after registration. Insurance carriers will be billed for the remaining half of their one-time costs and the cost of the first year of data collection on or after July 26, 2023, the Texas claim EDI release 3.1.4 implementation date.

All insurance carriers or insurance carrier groups must register their billing contact information with Verisk by June 13, 2022. To register, go to https://txdwcedi.info/ and select "Billing Registration" from the menu.
